Hydrogen Sulfide Test

Since hydrogen sulfide can be detected in water by "rotten egg" smell and taste, test strips are usually not needed to detect its presence.

Turn on the cold water; let it run for 1 minute and smell.
Turn off the cold water.


Turn on the hot water. Let it run for 1 minute and smell the water.

If the rotten egg smell is present in both, hydrogen sulfide is present in your water supply. If you detect it in the hot water only, the smell is from a reaction in your hot water heater.
